- You arrive at the venue no later than 8pm on the evening of your performance.

In return for your performance, we will:

- Advertise the event.
- Hold a jug collection, the proceeds of which will be given over to you, less club expenses.
[*However, any collections are determined by the audience and there can be no guarantee of any payments being made.*] Payments are in cash.
